

GENERAL

1. RunNUS 2020 (referred herein as the “Event”) is organised by the NUS Students’ Sports Club (referred herein as the “Organiser”) in accordance with these Rules and Regulations that are applicable to the participants.
2. Completion of the official entry form, including online registration, confirms the participant’s agreement to abide by the relevant Rules and Regulations of RunNUS 2020. These Rules and Regulations apply at the material time and to all any ruling of the Organiser.
3. The Participant agrees to provide true, accurate, current and complete information contained in the registration form. If the Participant provides any information that is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, or if the Organiser has grounds to suspect that such information is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, the Organiser may suspend or terminate the Participant’s registration.
4. The Organiser reserves the right to use any photographs, recordings of the Event for any legitimate purposes, including future promotional efforts.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to amend the Rules and Regulations without giving prior notification or any reasons thereof.

REGISTRATION

1. The Participant is considered to be registered for RunNUS 2020 only when (i) all and complete information is provided as specified in the online registration form and (ii) full payment of registration fees for the registered race category is duly made.
2. Once the registration form has been duly processed and the full payment of registration fees has been duly made, no amendment of registered race category will be allowed.
3. Participants who are found to have registered for the inappropriate race category that is of a lower fee will be required to pay the difference in fees between the registered and the correct race categories, if he/she wishes to continue to proceed in participating in the Event. No refunds will be made if Participant has already made payment for the incorrectly-registered race category and refuses to pay for the difference.
4. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Event at any time without prior notice to Participants, in which case they will inform Participants prior to the date of the Event. If the Event has to be cancelled or postponed, there shall be no refund of registration fees paid and the Organiser shall not be liable for any other loss or inconvenience caused.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to set the fees for the different categories as expedient to its intents and purposes.

6. The Organiser reserves the right to limit and refuse entries without assigning any reasons thereof.

7. The Organiser shall not be held responsible for any disputes arising from incomplete entry details.

8. Should a non-NUS student/alumni sign up as an NUS student/alumni, the participant will not be allowed to participate in the race (unless he/she re-applies for the public rate). No refunds will be given.

RACE PACK COLLECTION (RPC)

1. All Participants must collect their race packs within the stipulated RPC period (to be confirmed) in accordance to bluPort guidelines.
2. Uncollected race packs within the stipulated RPC period will be forfeited without any refunds/exchanges of similar value to Participant.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to replace the race pack items with items of similar value.

RACE: TECHNICAL GUIDELINES

Race categories for RunNUS 2020 are as follows:

Non-Competitive Categories

- 10km Men's and Women's Open
- 5km Men's and Women's Open
- 3km Challenge

1. The Organiser reserves the right to amend the RunNUS 2020 suggested race routes as they deem fit for the safety of the Participants and/or to prevent any potential hazards in the running of the event, at any time without prior notice to the Participant. In such cases, every effort will be made to inform the Participant prior to the date of the event. The Organiser shall not be liable for any other loss or inconvenience caused due to such changes.
2. Race entries are strictly non-transferable. Participants are only allowed to sign up for one race category and may not be allowed to transfer to another category.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify and/or refuse to verify results in entries that have been transferred without authorization or approval.
4. Runners who do not start the race after the stipulated run period will automatically be disqualified from the race. No refund will be offered to participants who missed the race window. Participants who have missed their window are not allowed to join other categories.

SAFETY & MEDICAL ADVISORY

1. Participants take part in RunNUS 2020 entirely at their own risk and are entirely responsible for selecting a safe route to run. Entrants should wear high visibility clothing when running in low light conditions and take care around traffic or when running off road. RunNUS 2020 and the organisations it supports accept no responsibility for any accidents or injuries sustained whilst taking part in RunNUS 2020.
2. For the safety of participants, participants are advised to run on designated pedestrian pathways and observe traffic regulations.
3. Due to the evolving COVID-19 situation, all participants are advised the following:
 - a. Do take your temperature before strenuous activities, and comply with SafeEntry at all sport facilities.
 - b. Only a maximum of 5 people are allowed should you wish to run in groups
 - c. Avoid touching common public objects with your hands or any part of your body
 - d. Always wear a mask unless you are doing strenuous activities
 - e. Observe a 2m safe distance while exercising

RACE CONDUCT

1. After completing the virtual race, participants must upload a run details photo (or multiple photos if you break the event down into several tries) to their event entry via the link <http://bit.ly/runnus2020submission>. Without a run details photo(s) participants will not have completed their virtual race and will not receive the finisher's medal and race pack. If participants experience any difficulties creating or uploading a run details photo(s), please contact the RunNUS 2020 team.
2. If participants do not submit run evidence within the stipulated result submission window, entitlements will not be sent out. The RunNUS 2020 team will make every effort to ensure participants receive the entitlements for their event, but if no run evidence is uploaded during the submission window, the RunNUS 2020 team cannot guarantee this will be the case.
3. RunNUS 2020 is not a competitive event and as such, there will be no winner of each category.
4. RunNUS 2020 will be free to use any images in which we are tagged on our social channels for any purpose.
